FREE CREDIT ADVICE FROM CORPORATE ATTORNEY

The next time you order checks have only your initials and last name put on them. If someone takes your checkbook, they will not know if you sign your checks with just your initials or your first name. Your bank will know how you sign your checks. If your checks are already printed with your entire name, fill out a new signature card at the bank and sign with your first initials and last name.

Do not sign the back of your credit cards. Instead, put "PHOTO ID REQUIRED."

When you are writing checks to pay on your credit cards, DO NOT put the complete account number on the memo line. Instead, just put the last four numbers. The credit card company knows the rest of the number, and anyone who might be handling your check as it passes through all the check processing channels won't have access to your account number.

Put your work phone number on your checks instead of your home phone. If you have a P.O. Box, use that instead of your home address. If you do not have a PO Box, use your work address.

Never have your Social Security # printed on your checks.

Photocopy the contents of your wallet. Copy both sides of your license, credit card, etc. Keep the copy in a safe place. You will know what you had in your wallet and all of the account numbers and phone numbers to call and cancel if your wallet is lost or stolen. You should also carry a photocopy of your passport when traveling.



Remembering September 11th

The fifth anniversary of the Sept. 11, 2001, attack will be commemorated in Prince William and at the Pentagon with small, subdued ceremonies as well as a much larger Freedom Walk around Washington, D.C.

Advance registration for The America Supports You Freedom Walk is required and will be held from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday and Friday at the Pentagon or online at americasupportsyou.mil until noon Saturday. The event is free and will take place Sunday.

In Prince William, a public wreath laying ceremony and candlelight vigil will be held at 8 p.m. Saturday at the new Liberty Memorial on the grounds of the McCoart Administration Center off Prince William Parkway.

The memorial, which was built and dedicated in May, was a community-driven effort to honor the 22 Prince William Area residents who died during the attacks. Prince William lost more residents during the attacks than any other jurisdiction in the Washington, D.C., area.

Its centerpiece is a pool of water in the shape of a pentagon. Two fountains that symbolize the World Trade Center towers shoot upward from the middle of the pool. A walkway made of Pennsylvania flagstone, representing Flight 93, surrounds the memorial that is ringed with newly planted trees. A block of stone from the Pentagon fire is incorporated into the design.

The names of those who perished are inscribed in stone on the side of the pool facing the front of the memorial. More than 400 people attended the dedication.

The public is invited to tour the Pentagon from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday. The tours will include the site of the attack and the Pentagon Chapel, where visitors can see the memorial stained glass window dedicated to those who died at the Pentagon during the attack.

At the conclusion of the walk, a tribute will be sung by opera singer Denyse Graves and an illumination ceremony will be held. The illumination ceremony will include 184 beams of light to commemorate each life lost in the attack on the Pentagon and each light will remain lit throughout Monday.

The Virginia Department Of Health Extends Breast And Cervical Cancer Screening To More Women

(RICHMOND, Va.)--The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) will increase the number of women it can screen and diagnose for breast and cervical cancer, thanks to funding allocated by the Virginia General Assembly. The funding was approved by Governor Tim Kaine in the 2006-2008 budget bill.

According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), many deaths from breast and cervical cancers could be prevented if cancer screening increased among women at risk.

Deaths from these diseases occur disproportionately among women who are uninsured or underinsured.

Effective July 1, the General Assembly earmarked \$405,176 for each year of the 2006-2008 biennium to expand VDH's Every Woman's Life Program. The money will allow VDH to screen and diagnose more women in the 40-49 age range and provide diagnostic services to income-eligible women aged 18-39 who have symptoms of breast cancer or abnormal cervical cancer screening results. VDH expects it can provide services to approximately 1,000 additional women. Those diagnosed by the program may be eligible for treatment through the Medicaid program.

"We are grateful to the Governor and General Assembly for these additional funds," said State Health Commissioner Robert B. Stroube, M.D., M.P.H. "The funds will help us continue to address the great need for screening and diagnostic services for breast and cervical cancer."

The Every Woman's Life Program primarily targets minority and geographically isolated Virginia women who are uninsured or underinsured and whose income is below 200 percent of the federal poverty level. The target age group is 50-64, but the program serves younger women as well. Since its inception in 1997, the program has screened 18,090 women and has established 24 screening sites around the state. Until now its sole source of funds was approximately \$2.4 million a year from the CDC.

"We do everything we can to screen as many women as possible," said Kathleen Rocco, director of the Every Woman's Life Program. The CDC allows the program to use 40 percent of its federal funds for administrative purposes. However, the program has cut its administrative costs to 20 percent and uses the savings to screen more women.
